Course Objectives	<p>By the end of this course participator will, have reached Beginner –High to Intermediate-Low proficiency in Arabic (according to ACTFL guidelines) which means that s/he will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1- Speak about himself /herself and his/her environment, initiate</li><li>2- Sustain conversations on a number of topics (e.g., family, friends, study, etc.,) and narrate in present, past and future time frames.</li><li>3- Read texts on familiar topics and understand the main ideas without using the dictionary Writing essential sentences about daily life.</li><li>4- Comprehend simple Arabic discourse dealing with familiar topics,</li><li>5- Carry out written transactions connected to daily life and write short letters and essays,</li><li>6- Be familiar with many aspects of Arab culture, such as social and religious customs and traditions, family life, and education,</li><li>7- Recognize and use verbs in all major tenses, recognize and form complex sentence structures such as dependent clauses, and recognize and use negation patterns</li></ol>



Course Content	<p><b>Course Key Topic Area Includes:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1- Simple short conversation and exchanges with around 1500 words and expression in daily life situations and news.</li><li>2- Reading simple short texts and news material.</li><li>3- Acting scenarios, and create them.</li><li>4- Listening to simple short conversations.</li><li>5- Some culture aspects</li></ol> <p>There will be no grammar explanations given during class time. We expect the learner to experiment grammar by actively reading, memorizing material in charts and preparing drills assigned.</p>
