Course Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Explain basic Japanese grammar.2. Practice basic four skills in Japanese (listening, speaking, reading, and writing).3. Foster spoken communication skill in the daily s4. Introduce general knowledge of the Japanese people and their culture, including non-verbal communication.
Course Content	Course Key Topic Area Includes: *This course is suitable for those who have completed up to Lesson 11 in Minna no Nihongo. This course is an introduction to Japanese language and culture, designed for those who have completed beginners level (=Japanese 2) or have equivalent knowledge of the Japanese language. Instruction will be given on the four skills of language (reading, speaking, listening, and writing), although emphasis will be placed on speaking and listening in order to help learners to acquire communicative skill for simple interaction with Japanese speakers.
Learning Outcomes	At the end of the program the trainees will be able to: Gain practical spoken communication skills for limited daily situations. <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Express your desire (<i>want to X</i>) and like/dislike, impression of objects, events etc (<i>adjectives</i>).2. Make a request. (<i>Please do X</i>)3. Make a comparison.4. Express action in progress (<i>-ing</i>) and state of being (e.g. <i>The bank is open</i>).5. Ask for permission and understand prohibition.6. Express potential (<i>I can do X</i>)7. Talk about past experience (e.g. <i>I have been to a Maid Cafe before</i>).
