Scoring:

- 3 points: All three categories described in detail
- 2 points: Two of the three categories described in detail
- 1 point: One of the categories described in detail
- 0 points: None of the categories described in detail

Data Sources

- $\sqrt{}$ Describe the test instruments used to measure achievement in a chosen content area (reading, math, etc.)
- $\sqrt{\text{Observations of student performance in the classroom}}$

Scoring:
