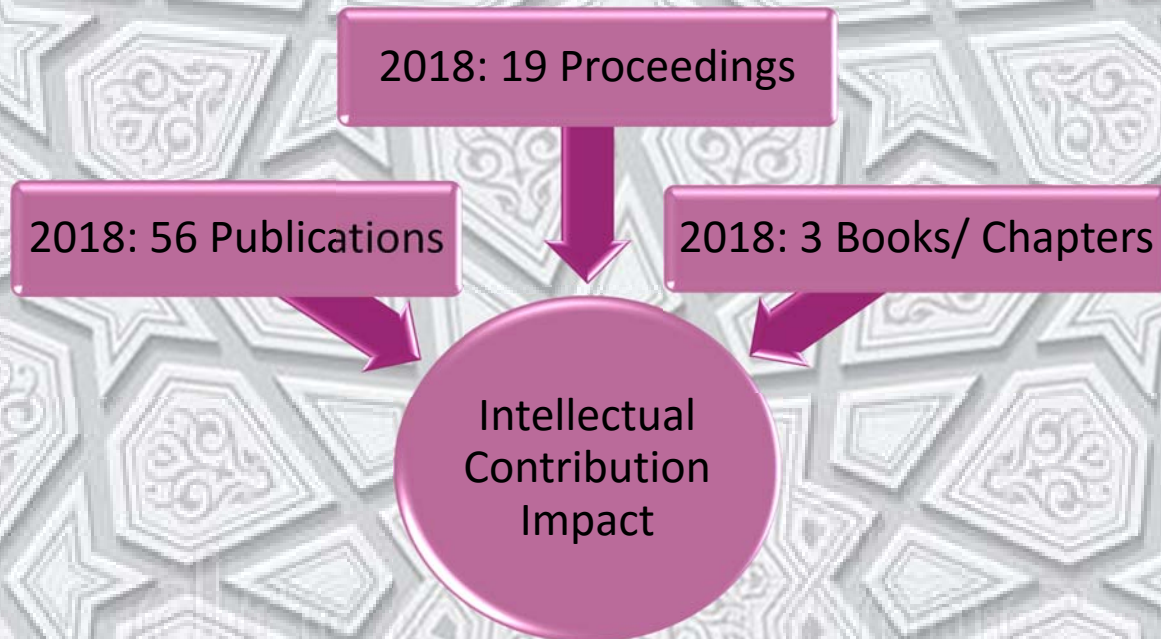


#### Public Key Infrastructure Session and Workshop

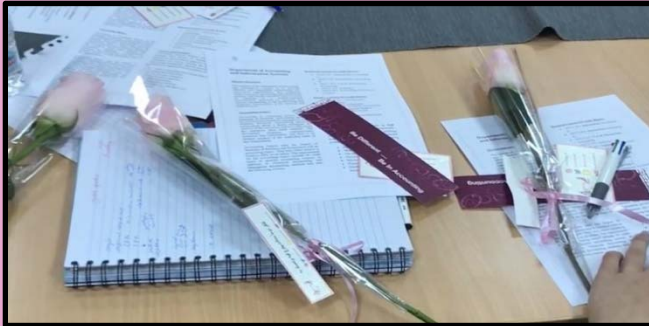
