


Wikis in Blackboard 9.1: *Instructions for faculty members*

To Create a Wiki in your course:


- 1- Login to your course on Blackborad 9.1
- 2- Add the Wiki tool link to the main menu by clicking on the **+** and then selecting "**Tool Link"** and "**Wikis**"



3- Click on the Wiki link on the left menu and then click on "Create Wiki"




4- In the Create Wiki Page, select your wiki options and submit



5- After **submitting**. The Wiki will be available to students according to the availability options that you selected.

To View and evaluate students' Wiki participations


1- From the Wiki page, open the wiki . You will see the full report page.




2- On the top right of the wiki page, you will find some information about the wiki, click on "**Participation and Grading**" to see a participation summary by student.




3- Click on the **students name** to view and evaluate individual's contributions



4- You will see a list of versions modified by the user that you selected. You can enter the students **grade** and **feedback** on the right menu. If you sat a rubric, you will be able to use it here.



5- If you click "**Compare to Version...**", you will be able to view the modifications that the selected user had done to this version.



6- Students grades that you enter here, will automatically go to the grade center.
