What is Microsoft Self-Service Password Reset (SSPR)?


SSPR is a tool that allows you to reset your password or unlock your account without having to contact the IT Services Department.


• Important: You must register your account for Multi-Factor Authentication before you can use SSPR.

How to Use SSPR

Follow these steps if you need to reset your password or unlock your account.

- 1 Visit https://id.qu.edu.qa
- Enter your QU email address (or username@qu.edu.qa)
- 3 Enter the characters in the picture or the words in the audio.
- 4 Click Next.
- 6 Choose your desired action:
- I forgot my password: to reset your password using the security information that you provided during the MFA registration process.
- **I know my password, but still can't sign in**: to unlock your account, in case it was automatically locked after repeated failed login attempts.





- 6 Choose a contact method you registered earlier for verification (e.g. Microsoft Authenticator app, your phone number, etc.).
- 7 Follow the on-screen instructions to get the verification code
- 8 Enter the code to verify your identity and click Next.
- 9 Follow the remaining prompts to create a new password or to unlock your account.
