Course Content

Course Key Topic Area Includes:

- Vowels and Consonants - Korean Alphabets.
- Korean sentence structure - Speak Greetings, Answer and Ask for simple personal information.
- To be, To have - Making simple sentence with Verb to be & to have and understanding locations and the meaning.
- Tenses - Present Tense, Past Tense, Future Tense, Progressive Tense and Past Perfect Tense.
- Negative Expression s- Word Negation, Do not and Can not.
- Particles - **Subject Particle(-이/가), Object Particle(-을/를), Location Particle(-에, 에서), Topic Particle(-은/는), etc. (10 kinds of particle).**
- **Vocabulary – Nationality, Occupation, Daily goods, family, friend, place, the body, food and animals.**
- To actively integrate culture with classroom instruction.



At the end of the program the trainees will be able to:

To read and write the Korean Alphabets

To Pronounce Korean words correctly.

To introduce self and respond to greetings.

To speak and Understand simple Korean sentences.

To recognize verb “to have” ,”to be”.

To talk about the location of people, place and things.

To understand Present Tense, Past Tense, Future Tense, Progressive Tense and Past Perfect Tense.

To express Negative.

To understand variety of Korean particles.

To recognize basic Korean vocabularies.

To understand learners with opportunities for meaningful language production by sharing their own experiences interculturally.
