Awards

All submissions will be evaluated based on their contribution towards the advancement of practice and theory as well as their potential contribution to entrepreneurship and sustainability. Prizes will be announced at the closing session of the conference.

- **Best Paper Awards:** the winner will be awarded the sum of \$1,500 and the runner-up will be awarded \$1,000.
- **Best Case Study Awards:** the winner will be awarded the sum of \$1,500 and the runner-up will be awarded \$1,000.
- Outstanding Dissertation-Based Paper Awards: five authors with the best PhD dissertation-based papers will be awarded funds covering travel and accommodation costs to attend the conference and present their papers. Outstanding papers will be published in the Management & Sustainability: An Arab Review (MSAR) journal. To be eligible, the papers must be dissertation-based, from candidates registered and/or completed their PhD degrees at Arab institutions, or from candidates at any recognized institutions worldwide with a focus on the Arab world.

Submission Guidelines

We welcome submission of abstracts and/or papers. Please submit a **1000-1500** word extended abstract (about 4 to 5 pages excluding references, appendices and other material) as a proposal for consideration at the conference. Full papers will also be accepted into the submission system. At least one author must attend the conference for the proposed paper to be included in the conference program.
