- Digitization, disruptive technologies and platforms
- Social entrepreneurship, frugal innovation and sustainable business models
- Industry 4.0 and sustainability

- Sustainable investment and corporate social responsibility
- Crisis management and organizational resilience

Submission Guidelines

Submission portal opens on the 15th April, 2023. We welcome submission of abstracts and/or papers.

Please submit a **1,000-1500 word extended abstract** (about 4 to 5 pages excluding references, appendices and other material) as a proposal for consideration at the conference. Full papers will also be accepted into the submission system. At least one author must attend the conference for the proposed paper to be included in the conference program.

Please note, even though the system has an abstract box, you still need to upload the short paper (in PDF or WORD file) as an attachment to complete the submission.
